GENERAL INFORMATION

HI-LOAD™ is a nonionic blend of surfactants and highly refined phytobland paraffin oil. It is designed for use with a broad range of pesticides where an oil concentrate adjuvant is recommended. **HI-LOAD™** increases contact activity and penetration of the spray while also providing uniform coverage on leaf surfaces. Always follow herbicide label recommendations.

NOTE: This product cannot be used for aquatic applications.

FIRST AID

- If Inhaled:** Remove to fresh air, treat symptomatically. Seek medical attention if irritation persists.
- If Swallowed:** **DO NOT INDUCE VOMITING. DO NOT GIVE LIQUIDS.** Seek immediate medical attention.

RECOMMENDED RATES

Ground, Aerial, Low volume, CDA:
Use 3-4 pints per 100 gallons water or .375-.50% v/v concentration.

MIXING

To prepare for pesticide application fill spray tank one-half full with water and begin agitation. Add pesticide or fertilizer as recommended and then add **HI-LOAD™** while continuing agitation. Continue to agitate until tank is full and agitate before and during each application.

NOTE: The effect of any adjuvant on a chemical's performance is not predictable under all conditions of weather, plant vigor, application methods and even water types. The user should consult his local agricultural extension agent or make his own tests to determine the optimum level of **HI-LOAD™** for special pesticide spray and crop.
