DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Agricultural Use

Use at the rate of 64 fl. Oz. to 96 fl. Oz. with 24 fl. oz. to 32 fl. oz. of Debug[®] Turbo per acre. Follow the application instructions given with Debug[®] Turbo product

SPILL AND LEAK CONTROL

Contain Spill or leak with sand, earth or inert material. Use cautious judgment when cleaning up large spills. Recover spill, put in suitable container immediately. Dispose of in accordance with local, state and federal regulations.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage and disposal.

Fill the container full with water and recap. Shake for 10 seconds. Pour rinsate into application equipment or a mix tank or store rinsate for later use or disposal. Drain for 10 seconds after the flow begins to drip. Repeat this procedure two more times. Then offer for recycling, if available or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill or by incineration. Do not burn unless allowed by state or local ordinances.
