STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Aquagene® 90 is a nonionic low-foam type surfactant. It incorporates the properties of a spreader and an activator when used with agricultural insecticides, fungicides, and herbicides. It is designed for quick wetting, more uniform droplet distribution and increased spray retention on leaf and stem surfaces.

APPLICATIONS

AQUAGENE® 90 RATE PER 100 GALLONS SPRAY MIX

Acaricides	4 - 8 Ounces
Defoliants	1/2 - 4 Pints
Desiccants	1/2 - 4 Pints
Fungicides	4 - 8 Ounces
Herbicides	1/2 - 4 Pints
Insecticides	4 - 8 Ounces

FOR SPECIFIC RATES OF SURFACTANT, REFER TO PRODUCT LABELS.

In difficult wetting situations (such as hard water or mature waxy foliage) use the higher rate.

NOTE: Due to variations in materials, application equipment, waters, and other conditions, the optimum use rate may vary. Use enough Aquagene® 90 to form a smooth uniform spray deposit.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not store near heat or open flame.

Container Disposal: Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or incineration or, if allowed by State and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke.
