General Information

INFIELD is a convenient, ready-to-use spray additive and is intended for use with herbicides that recommend the addition of Ammonium Sulfate to the spray solution. Uptake is enhanced by the ammonium ion source. INFIELD also increases efficiency by improving drift control characteristics and deposition of the spray solution. Sound application technology and procedures must be followed when applying pesticides. INFIELD is compatible with most pesticides. INFIELD buffers spray solutions to prevent hydrolysis and ties up antagonistic ions found in hard water. Always use this product in accordance with instructions concerning adjuvants contained in the pesticide label.

Directions For Use

For the addition of 8.5 pounds of Ammonium Sulfate per 100 gallons of spray solution, add one 2.5 gallon container of INFIELD per 100 gallons, or 2.5% v/v. INFIELD contains the proper amount of Deposition Aid and Defoamer for use at this rate.

Always add INFIELD to the spray solution first, to allow it to buffer hard waters, before the addition of pesticides. Add pesticides to the tank in the sequence recommended on the pesticide label.

Directions For Mixing

Add 2/3 of the required water to the spray tank. With agitation running, add INFIELD. While adding the remaining water and with the agitation running, add the pesticide. Maintain agitation while spraying to ensure a uniform mixture.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed. Avoid breathing spray mists or vapors. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Avoid contamination of feed or foodstuffs.

PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT (PPE): Long-sleeved shirt and long pants, socks, shoes, gloves, and protective eyewear.

FIRST AID

IF SWALLOWED: Immediately call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by the poison control center or doctor. Do not give ANY liquid to the person. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING: Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

IF IN EYES: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

IF INHALED: Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-mouth if possible. Call a poison control center or doctor for further treatment advice.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

Do not apply directly to water, or to areas where surface water is present or to intertidal areas below the mean high water mark. Do not contaminate water when cleaning equipment or disposing of equipment washwaters.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry, locked area out of reach of children. Protect from excessive heat. Keep container tightly closed in storage to prevent entry of water.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Waste resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by incineration, or if allowed by state and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke.
