GENERAL INFORMATION

LINK 44 is a foliarly-applied primary plant nutrient product and is non-phytotoxic when used as directed. LINK 44 is available and absorbed on the leaf surface. As a foliar nutrient, LINK 44 is intended solely as a supplement to a well-balanced, existing soil fertilization program. Application of LINK 44 will reduce primary nutrient deficiencies occurring during periods of rapid plant growth or physiological stress.

LINK 44 should be used as part of a comprehensive Total Nutrition System® for optimizing plant growth, development, yield and quality.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Add 1/2 water to tank before adding LINK 44. Agitate while adding remaining water. Dilution rate is not critical, however, do not exceed 1/2 pint of LINK 44 per gallon of water. LINK 44 is compatible with most pesticides and can be applied with existing spray programs.

LINK 44 may be applied as a foliar spray by air, ground concentrate or dilute. Maintain agitation to provide uniform distribution within spray tank. Use of a high quality CPDA approved spreader such as R-11® at recommended rates to improve spray cover is usually advised. Do not apply when plants are under excessive heat or moisture stress. Applications of foliar nutrients to leafy vegetables or soft-skinned fruits during periods of excessive temperatures may cause cosmetic injury. Applications of certain micronutrients to fleshy fruits within 30 days of harvest may result in staining of rind or skin.

Cool Season Turf: For bentgrass, bluegrass, fescue, ryegrass and other cool season grasses, apply 2-4 ounces per 1,000 sq. ft. in a minimum of 1 gallon of water.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE (cont.)

Warm Season Turf: For Bermuda grass, St. Augustine, Zoysia and other warm season grasses, apply 4-5 ounces per 1,000 sq. ft. in a minimum of 1 gallon of water.

Herbaceous Plants: Including annual and perennial flowers, apply 1/2 to 1 pint per 25 gallons of water. Spray to the point of runoff.

Trees: Apply 1-2 pints per 100 gallons and spray to cover.

Sprinkler Injection: May be injected at a rate of 4-8 ounces per 1,000 sq. ft. on turf or 8-16 ounces per 1,000 sq. ft. on herbaceous plantings. Apply as needed but do not apply more than 2 times per month.
