GENERAL INFORMATION

Use The Andersons 25-2-8 for turf, landscape ornamentals, trees and shrubs. Fertilizer will release for 2 to 3 months at average soil temperatures of 70°F.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Apply only as directed during the growing season (see suggested spreader settings). Apply to ornamentals during the growing season, and remove fertilizer granules from the foliage, where possible, by lightly shaking the foliage.

ON SELECTED TURF AREAS:

Broadcast 130-174 pounds of product per acre to maintain desirable color and density. Reduce application rate in summer months and water in where possible.

Recent research has shown that well-maintained turf is an effective environmental buffer that prevents pollutants from entering our natural water bodies. To help protect these natural resources, avoid applying product to sidewalks, driveways, roadways, and other impervious surfaces. Sweep any misplaced granules back onto the area you are treating immediately after application, since storm drains often empty directly to nearby waterways.

LANDSCAPE AND ORNAMENTAL APPLICATIONS:

Because of the variety of plants, different growing media, and variable climates, recommended application rates are not provided. Use rate for particular species of plant. This product can be incorporated into landscape bed soils compatible with local conditions and soil types.

NURSERY STOCK (FIELD GROWN) AND LANDSCAPE GOLF COURSE ORNAMENTALS:

For mineral soils: Uniformly apply fertilizer to the area surrounding the target plants. Apply at the HEAVY rate (260 pounds/acre) in the spring just as the plants break dormancy. Apply again at the HEAVY rate in June. After each application, lightly cover fertilizer with soil or mulch if possible.

For highly sandy soils: Uniformly apply fertilizer to the area surrounding the target plants. Apply at the HIGH rate (218 pounds/acre) a total of three times per season. Make the first application at the HIGH rate in the spring. Make the second application at the HIGH rate in the summer. Make the third application at the HIGH rate in late fall. After each application, lightly cover fertilizer with soil or mulch if possible.

STORAGE AND USE

Store in a clean, dry place. Reseal opened bag by folding top down and securing. Use only in clean, dry spreaders. Do not leave unused product in spreaders.
