DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Follow all applicable directions, restrictions, and precautions including statements pertaining to the Worker Protection Standard on the EPA-registered label.

This labeling must be in the possession of the user at the time of herbicide application.

DILL

Make one pre-emergence (post planting) or one post-emergence application of Caparol® 4L at the rates of 3.2 pt/Acre 1.6 lb active ingredient (ai)/Acre per application at least 30 days before harvest.

Make uniform applications of the herbicide in a minimum of 20 gallons of water per acre.

Restrictions

1. Do not apply more than 3.2 pints of Caparol 4L (1.6 lb of prometryn) per acre per season.
2. Do not harvest within 30 days of application.

To Avoid Injury to Dill:

1. Use on sand or loamy sand may delay emergence or thin the stand. Postemergence application may delay maturity.
2. Do not apply if dill is under water stress.
3. Do not apply Caparol 4L postemergence with other pesticides. Apply only after foliar applications of other pesticides are dry.
4. Do not apply within 2 weeks after an application of an herbicidal oil.
