Directions for Use

Location: Statewide

Crop/Site/Commodity: Alfalfa

Target Pest/Problem: Dodder Weed

Dosage: Apply 20 lb product (2 lb a.i.) per acre prior to weed emergence. Apply an additional 20 lb product (2 lb a.i.) per acre approximately 60 days after the first application.

A single rainfall or overhead sprinkler irrigation of 0.5 inches or more or flood irrigation after application is required to activate Treflan. If this does not occur within 10 days after application, Treflan should be activated using incorporation equipment that will insure thorough soil mixing with minimum damage to the established alfalfa.

Dilution Rate: See "Dosage" above

Method of Application: Ground or Aerial

Frequency/Timing of Application: Apply the first application to established alfalfa stands prior to weed emergence. Make a second application approximately 60 days after the first application.

Field Reentry After Application: N/A

Preharvest Interval: N/A

Other Requirements:

- In the season following a 20 pound per acre treatment with Treflan TR-10, where established alfalfa is to be rotated to another crop, plant only those crops for which Treflan can be applied as a preplant incorporated treatment or injury may result.
- Valid until withdrawn, suspended or canceled by the EPA, Dow AgroSciences, or the California Department of Food and Agriculture.
