	Wireworms	3 - 4 qts.	Broadcast just before planting and immediately incorporate into the top 4 - 8 inches of soil.
POTATOES The Restricted Entry Interval is 3 days.	Cutworms (Surface and Subterranean)	2 - 4 qts.	Broadcast just before planting and immediately incorporate into the soil. See Soil Incorporation note.
	Wireworms	3 - 4 qts.	Broadcast just before planting and immediately incorporate into the top 4 - 8 inches of soil.
	Southern Potato Wireworms (Southeastern U.S.)	2 - 4 qts.	For potatoes grown on mineral soils in the Southeast, apply before planting and immediately incorporate into the top 3 - 6 inches of soil depending on location of wireworms.

SWEET POTATOES The Restricted Entry Interval is 3 days.	Wireworms	3 - 4 qts.	Broadcast just before planting and immediately incorporate into the top 4 - 8 inches of soil.
SWISS CHARD The Restricted Entry Interval is 3 days.	Cutworms	2 - 4 qts.	Broadcast just before planting and immediately incorporate into the soil. See Soil Incorporation note.
	Wireworms	3 - 4 qts.	Broadcast just before planting and immediately incorporate into the top 4 - 8 inches of soil.
TURNIPS (Roots and Tops) The Restricted Entry Interval is 3 days.	Cutworms	2 - 4 qts.	Broadcast just before planting and immediately incorporate into the soil. See Soil Incorporation note.
	Mole Crickets	1 qt.	One to two days before planting, broadcast and immediately incorporate into the top 1 - 2 inches of soil.
	Wireworms	3 - 4 qts.	Broadcast just before planting and immediately incorporate into the top 4 - 8 inches of soil.

RESTRICTIONS FOR ALL CROPS:

Make a maximum of one soil application per growing season.
