Control of Annual Weeds in Bermudagrass Highway Rights-of-Way:

Apply up to 1.1 lbs. of AAtrex Nine-O in 20 to 80 gallons of water per acre for control of annual bluegrass, black nightshade, cheat, cocklebur*, common hop clover, (annual) broomweed, downy brome, Japanese brome, foxtails, horseweed (marestail)*, kochia, lambsquarters, little barley, mustards, pigweed (carelessweed) poorjoe, ragweed, Russian thistle*, smartweed, smutgrass, sunflower, wild lettuce, and wild oats. For control of summer annual weeds, apply AAtrex Nine-O in the spring before weeds emerge.

*Weeds Partially Controlled

Note: To avoid illegal residues, 1) **DO NOT** cut or feed grass hay from highway rights of way. 2) **DO NOT** allow livestock to graze treated areas. 3) Make only one application per year.

Following many years of continuous use of this product and chemically related products, biotypes of some of the weeds listed on this label have been reported which cannot be effectively controlled by this and related herbicides. Where this is known or suspected, and weeds controlled by this product are expected to be present along with resistant biotypes, we recommend the use of this product in combinations or in sequence with other registered herbicides which are not triazines. If only resistant biotypes are expected to be present, use a registered non-triazine herbicide. Consult with your state Agricultural Extension Service for specific recommendations.
