



## Section 2(ee) Recommendation

Products: Quadris® Opti Fungicide  
EPA Reg. No. 100-1171

Use: Lower rates for control of early blight (*Alternaria solani*) and late blight (*Phytophthora infestans*) in tomatoes

States: Indiana, Michigan, Ohio

This is a recommendation of FIFRA Section 2(ee) as it relates to the use of a lower rate of Quadris Opti for the control of early blight and late blight in tomato. The user must refer to the federally approved label for Quadris Opti and read and follow all directions for use, restrictions, and precautions.

### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

#### Tomato

**Early blight and Late blight:** Apply 1.3 – 1.6 pints of Quadris Opti per acre for control of early blight and late blight. Applications should begin prior to disease development and continue throughout the season following the resistance management guidelines. Apply on a 5-7 day schedule and use higher rate if late blight is present.

Do not apply more than 0.5 lb ai/A of azoxystrobin containing products per season.

Do not apply more than 15.0 lb ai/A of chlorothalonil or chlorothalonil-containing products per acre per year.

May be applied the day of harvest.
