DIRECTIONS FOR USE

This product is not intended for foliar applications.

SOIL APPLICATIONS:

Soil apply via mechanical application through direct spray or injection to the soil (broadcast, banded, soil injection, side dress). Mix in clean tank with sufficient water for adequate mixing and coverage of target areas.

WATER RUN:

This material may be water run via drip, micro sprinklers, flood, and furrow. When applying this material via a fertigation system, continue to operate the system 30-60 minutes after material has completely injected to flush clean water through the system.

PRECAUTIONS:

- Since many pesticide products can be neutralized and/or tied up by soil organic matter, it is highly recommended not to use pesticides applied directly with humic acids. Consult pesticide representative before using on a large scale.
- Agitate prior to use.
- Due to the dark color of this material, avoid application methods that may cause this product to come into contact with the harvested portion of the plant, to avoid spotting.
- Avoid application methods that may cause this product to come into contact with produce intended for human consumption.

COMPATIBILITY:

This product has an acidic pH and is compatible with many commonly applied nutrients and crop protection products. Contact a Source To Source representative for a list of compatible mixes. Jar test for compatibility prior to mixing with any pesticides, fertilizers or fertilizer blends. For unfamiliar mixes, an appropriate amount of the final mix should be applied to a small area of the intended crop to ensure plant compatibility prior to the planned application. STORAGE AND DISPOSAL:

SOURCE TO SOURCE SUGGESTED RATES AND TIMINGS:

Trees & Vines:

Apply 10-15 gals of Broad Bio per acre, starting at the first root flush of the season. Repeat in 14 day intervals, as needed, up to 14 days prior to harvest. Do not exceed a season maximum total of 60 gallons per acre.

Row Crops:

Apply 10-15 gals of Broad Bio per acre as a pre plant, starter, side dress or in water runs. Apply in 14 day intervals. Do not exceed a season maximum total of 60 gallons per acre.
