#### ORNAMENTAL LAWNS AND TURF

Apply this product at the rate of 2-1/2 to 3-1/2 pints in 20 to 240 gallons of water per acre (0.91 to 1.29 fluid ounces in 0.5 to 5.5 gallons of water per 1,000 square feet) to Birdsfoot Trefoil growing in turf planted to Bluegrass, Fescue, Rye, Bent (excluding golf greens and tees), Bahia, Bermuda and Zoysia.

Avoid drift of spray mist to vegetables, flowers, ornamental plants, shrubs, trees and other desirable plants. Do not pour spray solutions near desirable plants. Do not use on Carpetgrass, Dichondra, nor on lawns or turf where desirable clovers are present. Use lawn type sprayer with coarse spray as wind drift is less likely. Avoid contact with exposed feeder roots of ornamentals and trees. Maximum control (or killing) of weeds will be obtained from spring or early fall applications when weeds are actively growing. Use the higher rate for dense population of large weeds. Do not exceed specified dosages for any area; be particularly careful within the dripline of trees and other ornamental species. Do not apply to newly seeded grasses until well established. Avoid broadcast applications when air temperature exceeds 85°F. When using small, spot treatment applications in temperature over 85°F, turf injury may occur.

Do not apply more than 1.5 lbs. ae of MCPA or 4 pints of product per acre per year.

Do not apply more than 2 applications per year with a minimum retreatment interval of 21 days.
