

PEARS - 200 PPM

Limitations, Restrictions, and Exceptions

Use Directions

Begin spray application at 10% bloom at a rate of 50-100 gals. of solution per acre. Repeat applications at 4 to 6 day intervals. This may involve up to 8-10 applications.

Do not apply within 60 days of harvest.

Use of FLAMEOUT may cause phytotoxicity to the fruit and/or foliage of sensitive varieties of pears, especially Asian varieties.

Additional information regarding use of FLAMEOUT fungicide/bactericide may be obtained from your local Agricultural Extension Agent or State Experimental Station.
