

LAWNS - CENTIPEDES, MILLIPEDES, PAVEMENT ANTS

General Information

- Use on lawns, ornamental and flower gardens, and vegetables
- Soil-penetrating formula reaches deep below ground
- Kills listed surface & sub-surface insects

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Apply this product directly to the lawn or garden area. Water treated area as directed on the label. Do not water to the point of run-off. Do not make applications during the rain. Application is prohibited directly into sewers or drains, or to any area like a gutter where drainage to sewers, storm drains, water bodies, or aquatic habitat can occur. Do not allow the product to enter any drain during or after application.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

This product is for use on lawns, around home foundations (perimeter treatment), ornamental and flower gardens, and vegetable gardens for the control of the insect pests listed.

Limitations, Restrictions, and Exceptions

LAWNS

Apply this product when insect activity or damage is first observed (lawn thins, brown spots appear, or moths fly up from the grass when mowed). Spread this product uniformly over lawn at the rates listed. Water-in product after application. Do not use any other weed, disease, or insect control products for at least one week after application. For best results and to prevent further damage, treat the entire lawn, not just the browned areas. Repeat application if there are signs of renewed insect activity.

NOTE: Food utensils such as tablespoons/teaspoons must not be used for food

purposes after use in measuring pesticides.

In New York State, this product may NOT be applied to any grass or turf area (lawns) within 100 feet of a water body (lake, pond, river, stream, wetland, or drainage ditch).

In New York State, do make a single repeat application of this product if there are signs of renewed insect activity, but not sooner than two weeks after the first application.
