

LAWN PESTS (OUTDOORS) - BELOW THE GROUND INSECTS

General Information

- Use on Trees, Shrubs, Roses, Flowers, Lawns and Other Landscape Plantings
- For Above The Ground and Below The Ground Insects
- Control: Ants, Grasshoppers, Aphids, Bagworms, Gypsy Moth Caterpillars, Japanese Beetle (adults), Whiteflies
- 1 Quart (32 Fl. Oz.) Treats Up To 10,600 Sq. Ft.
- Fast-Acting

Limitations, Restrictions, and Exceptions

LAWN PESTS (OUTDOORS) - BELOW THE GROUND INSECTS:

HOW TO APPLY:

- Measure lawn. Calculate square feet by multiplying length times width.
- Spray evenly over measured lawn. Treat entire lawn.

WHEN TO REAPPLY:

- Repeat application is necessary only if there are signs of renewed insect activity. Repeat application must be limited to no more than once per seven days.

AMOUNT TO USE:

For Concentrate: 0.5 Fl. Oz. (1 Tbs.) per gallon of water sprayed over 167 sq. ft.

For Ready-To-Spray: No measuring or mixing is required. Automatically dilutes as you spray.
