

LANDSCAPE, ORNAMENTAL AND TREE PESTS (OUTDOORS)

General Information

- Use on Trees, Shrubs, Roses, Flowers, Lawns and Other Landscape Plantings

- For Above The Ground and Below The Ground

Insects

- Control: Ants, Grasshoppers, Aphids, Bagworms, Gypsy Moth Caterpillars, Japanese Beetle (adults), Whiteflies

- 1 Quart (32 Fl. Oz.) Treats Up To 10,600 Sq. Ft.

- Fast-Acting

Limitations, Restrictions, and Exceptions

LANDSCAPE, ORNAMENTAL AND TREE PESTS (OUTDOORS):

HOW TO APPLY

- Spray evenly over foliage and treatment surfaces to the point of runoff.

WHEN TO REAPPLY

- Repeat application is necessary only if there are signs of renewed insect activity. Repeat application must be limited to no more than once per seven days.

For Bagworms, apply when larvae begin to hatch and spray larvae directly. Application when larvae are young will be most effective.

For Beetles, Scale Crawlers, Twig Borers, and Weevils: Treat tree trunks, stems, and twigs in addition to plant foliage.

Mosquitoes coming to rest on areas treated for the control of lawn and home-invading pests will be killed for varying periods of time after application, depending on exposure of treated areas to environmental conditions.

IMPORTANT: Soil in the vicinity of wells, cisterns or ponds must not be treated. For those situations, contact your County Cooperative Extension Agent or consult a commercial pest control service. **DO NOT** treat soil that is water saturated or frozen,

or in any conditions where run-off or movement from the treatment area (or site) is likely to occur. DO NOT apply while it is raining. DO NOT use on pets. DO NOT use on edible plants. Spray drift onto these plants must be rinsed off immediately with water.
