

# PECAN

## Limitations, Restrictions, and Exceptions

Make foliar applications as pest pressure begins to increase. Make a second application 10 to 14 days after first if field scouting reveals continued pest pressure. Use of an organosilicone based spray adjuvant at recommended rate can insure thorough coverage of foliage.

## Notes and Restrictions for residential Pecan Trees:

- Do not apply more than a total of 18.0 fluid ounces of MIDASH 2SC T&O per acre per year.
- Do not make more than 3 applications.
- Allow 10 or more days between applications.
- Application rate per acre will depend on tree size and volume of foliage present. The rate per acre is based on a standard of 400 gallons of dilute spray solution per acre for large trees.
