

## **FRUIT CROPS: STRAWBERRIES**

### General Information

CAUTION: The application of fertilizing materials containing molybdenum (Mo) may result in crops containing levels of molybdenum (Mo) which are toxic to ruminant animals.

CAUTION: This product contains boron, therefore must only be used on crops listed on the label at the recommended rates and according to the directions for use. The use of this fertilizer material on any other crops may result in serious crop injury.

### Limitations, Restrictions, and Exceptions

#### FRUIT CROPS

Apply BM86 to most fruit crops at pre-bloom, full bloom and soon after fruit set at a rate of 1 quart, 3 pints or 2 quarts per acre depending on the fruit crop.

#### STRAWBERRIES

- 1) Within 14 days of transplant.
- 2) At first bloom.
- 3) 14-21 days later.

Subsequent applications:

Every 14-21 days thereafter.
