Three Easy Steps to use this Product

Step #1: Determine size of the job, measure the area to be treated.

Step #2: Use spreader setting chart in the label to determine appropriate setting for your spreader.

Step # 3: Treat as directed in Rate chart in the label. Thorough coverage is important. Water in granules where indicated.

Note: The spreader settings listed are approximate. Accurately weigh a few pounds into your spreader and apply to a measured area. Then adjust spreader setting, if necessary, in order, in order to assure correct rate of application.

Limitations, Restrictions, and Exceptions

Use Rate:

Apply 1 cup over and 2 feet around, each fire ant mound.

How to Use:

Water thoroughly, immediately after application. A minimum of 1 gallon of water should be applied to each mound area. Apply gently to avoid disturbing ants. Use of high pressure watering equipment may disturb the ants and cause migration, reducing product effectiveness.

Note: For best results, apply in early or late evening hours. Treat new mounds as they appear.
