

# **CELERIAC**

## General Information

Resistance Management: Because of the inherent risks of resistance development to any product, it is strongly advised that Solera Abamectin Agricultural Miticide/Insecticide be used in a sound resistance management program that includes rotation with other products with different modes of action.

## Limitations, Restrictions, and Exceptions

### CELERIAC

#### Application Instructions - Celeriac

- Solera Abamectin Agricultural Miticide/Insecticide may be applied using conventional or concentrate sprayers calibrated to deliver sufficient water for thorough coverage of the foliage.
- For best results, use in combination with a non-ionic surfactant.
- Apply when mites first appear and repeat as necessary to maintain control.

#### Use Restrictions

- Do not apply at less than 7-day intervals.
- Do not exceed 48 fl. oz./A after transplanting.
- Do not apply in less than 20 gals. of water per acre.
- For resistance management purposes, use no more than 2 sequential applications

Exception: For grape girdling, cane turning, and tying in grapes, do not enter or allow worker entry into treated areas during the restricted-entry interval (REI) of 4-days.
