GENERAL INFORMATION

Bonide Compost Maker is a non-corrosive and nonvolatile. It supports microbial cultures that feed on moist organic matter. By their digestion, they produce stable humus in compost.

COMPOSTING TIPS

Any ground up organic materials, such as leaves, straw, kitchen scraps, grass clippings or manure will compost. Arrange materials in 4 inch layers. Sprinkle a light dusting of Compost Maker over each layer. Keep moist. Compost Maker will help accelerate the decomposition process.

- Energize composts and decomposing organic matter.
- Aids in Accelerating the digestion of organic residues in compost.
- Helps Stabilize nutrients and humus, reduces odors.

Limitations, Restrictions, and Exceptions

COMPOST PILES, DRUMS, OR BINS

Incorporate one pound Compost Maker per 500 to 1000 pounds of raw materials (10-20 cubic feet). Provide adequate moisture, aeration and nitrogenous materials.
