

# TRANSPLANTING BARE ROOTED/CONTAINER PLANTS

## General Information

## Limitations, Restrictions, and Exceptions

Transplanting Bare Rooted/Container Plants (roses, azaleas, camellias, gardenias, hibiscus, holly and similar type ornamental plants and shrubs). Add 6 tablespoons (3 fl. oz.) to 1 gal. water. Pour 1/2 gal. of this diluted mixture into the planting hole and over the soil as the roots are being covered.
