General Information

METHYLATED SOYBEAN OIL is a multicomponent herbicide spray adjuvant derived from methylated soybean oil and a nonionic surfactant blend. University tests have shown that methylated seed oils plus surfactant blends provide improved performance of certain postemergent herbicides. METHYLATED SOYBEAN OIL will provide improved leaf coverage and retention of herbicides on leaf surfaces for enhanced control of weeds under temperature or moisture stress.

METHYLATED SOYBEAN OIL may be used as a substitute when herbicide labels recommend the addition of a crop oil concentrate or either a nonionic surfactant or crop oil concentrate to the spray mixture. Always refer to the herbicide label for additional recommendations and precautions.

ALWAYS ADD SURFACTANT LAST TO THE SPRAY MIX AND CONTINUE AGITATION WHILE FILLING THE TANK.

Limitations, Restrictions, and Exceptions

The higher rate may be required when weeds are stressed due to heat or drought or populations are extremely high.
