

COLE CROPS - BRASSICA LEAFY VEGETABLES - BROCCOLI

General Information

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

Apply AMBUSH Insecticide as shown in Directions for Application. Use sufficient water to obtain full coverage of foliage. Timing and frequency of applications should be based upon insect populations reaching economic thresholds. The higher rates may be required under conditions of heavy infestation. Do not apply more than 2.0 lbs. a.i./A per season. Crops in the label may be planted immediately after last treatment. Do not plant other crops within 60 days after last application. Any other crop may be planted if it is not harvested or grazed.

Resistance

Some insects are known to develop resistance to products used repeatedly for control. Because the development of resistance cannot be predicted, the use of this product should conform to resistance management strategies established for the use area. Consult your local or state agricultural authorities for details.

If resistance to this product develops in your area, this product, or other products with a similar mode of action, may not provide adequate control. If poor performance cannot be attributed to improper application or extreme weather conditions, a resistant strain of insect may be present. If you experience difficulty with control and resistance is a reasonable cause, immediately consult your local company representative or agricultural advisor for the best alternative method of control for your area.

Limitations, Restrictions, and Exceptions

Remarks

Apply by air or ground equipment. By air, apply in a minimum of 2 gal. of water/A. By ground, apply in a minimum of 10 gal. of water/A. Use sufficient water to obtain full coverage of foliage. Apply every 5 days or as needed.
