

## **CORN (FOLIAR)**

### General Information

Refer in the label for the Corn Insecticide Applicator Settings.

### Limitations, Restrictions, and Exceptions

### Method of Application

When treating for Armyworms, Cutworms, European Corn Borer, Southwestern Corn Borer and Western Bean cutworm apply when eggs begin to hatch. For treatment of Stalk Borers, Pounce 1.5 G must be applied when or shortly before the Stalk Borer larvae are moving into the corn from

the surrounding weeds and grasses. Mowing or burndown herbicide is suggested to initiate movement of Stalk Borer larvae. Apply by aircraft

broadcasting over corn plants or with ground equipment by directing the granule into the whorl.

Do not make treatments less than 7 days apart or apply less than 30 days prior to harvest of grain or fodder (stover).

Forage may be harvested on the day of application.
