

SWEET CORN (FOLIAR)

General Information

Refer in the label for the Corn Insecticide Applicator Settings.

Limitations, Restrictions, and Exceptions

Method of Application

When treating for Armyworms, Western Bean Cutworm, Southwestern Corn Borer, and European corn Borer apply when eggs begin to hatch. For treatment of Stalk Borer, Pounce 1.5 G must be applied when or shortly before the Stalk Borer larvae are moving into sweet corn from the surrounding weeds and grasses. Mowing or burndown herbicide is suggested to initiate movement of Stalk Borer larvae. Apply by aircraft by broadcasting over sweet corn plants or with ground equipment by directing the granule into the whorl.

Apply every 3 days or as needed.

Do not make applications less than 3 days apart.
