

IRRIGATION INJECTION

General Information

MIX WELL BEFORE USING

HydraFlo is a liquid surfactant that enhances wettability of soils and/or root substrates, thereby enhancing penetration of water and other water soluble materials.

Directions For Use: Incorporation of HydraFlo into the soil is not required; it may be surface applied for pre- or post-emergence applications. HydraFlo may be used at any time of year though preferred application times are early spring (prior to or at planting or break in dormancy of perennial crops) and fall, after harvest of annual or perennial crops.

Compatibility & Mixing: Always read and follow label instructions for this product and for all accompanying tank mix products. HydraFlo is believed to be compatible with most crop protection products. Conduct a jar test to confirm compatibility prior to large scale applications. Fill spray tank half full with water without agitation. Add HydraFlo after all other tank mix products, fill remaining water and begin agitation. The use of an antifoam agent is recommended.

Limitations, Restrictions, and Exceptions

Irrigation Injection: HydraFlo can be injected into irrigation systems at a rate of four to eight fluid ounces per acre initially, followed by two fluid ounces per acre during subsequent irrigations, if needed.
