

ALFALFA - COLORADO

General Information

USE RESTRICTIONS

Do not apply in spray solution above pH 10.

It is best to use COMITE II at pH 7 or lower.

Unless the rotated crop is a registered use for propargite, the following applies:

Do not plant any root crop in rotation within 6 months after last application of propargite to labeled crops.

Do not plant other crops in rotation within 2 months after last application of propargite to labeled crops.

Registered-labeled field and vegetable uses for propargite are:

Beans, dry Jojoba Seed crops only:

Corn (sweet, Mint Alfalfa field and popcorn) Peanuts, Carrot, Cotton, Potatoes, Clover,,Hops, Sorghum, Sugar Beets.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

COMITE II is a liquid emulsifiable concentrate for preparing sprays to control mites.

COMITE II is not systemic in action, therefore complete coverage of both upper and lower leaf surfaces and of fruit is necessary for effective control. COMITE II can be used in concentrate sprays as directed by label.

COMITE II performance is best when day temperatures average above 70°F.

Limitations, Restrictions, and Exceptions

ALFALFA (Grown for Seed Purposes Only)

NOTE:

The feeding of treated foliage, alfalfa trash or seed screenings to livestock and the grazing of treated fields is prohibited.

All alfalfa seed grown or conditioned as a non-food or non-feed site in the state of Colorado shall bear a tag or a container label which forbids the use of seed for human consumption or animal food. It shall be the grower's responsibility to notify the processing plants of any seed crop treated with COMITE II.

No alfalfa seed grown or conditioned as a non-food or non-feed site in the state of Colorado may be distributed for human consumption or animal feed.

Treated alfalfa seed is not to be used for sprouting.

COMITE II is not hazardous to bees when used alone. However, bee hazards may be encountered when combined with other insecticides. Observe State Department of Agriculture regulations on the use of insecticides for seed alfalfa.

COMITE II is compatible with most insecticides. Check COMITE II label and information handbook for details.
