

## **FOR POCKET GOPHERS - PLUG REMOVAL BAITING**

### General Information

#### USE RESTRICTIONS:

- This product may only be applied against the pest listed on the label, at the use sites listed on the label, and by the application methods listed on the label.
- This product may only be used to control pocket gophers in manual, below-ground applications in lawns.
- Bait must be applied directly into the burrow systems.
- Do not apply in gardens and areas where food or feed may become contaminated.
- Do not apply this product by the use of an artificial burrow builder.

### Limitations, Restrictions, and Exceptions

#### FOR POCKET GOPHERS - PLUG REMOVAL BAITING:

Burrowing pocket gophers (*Thomomys* spp. and *Geomys* spp.) throw out low, fan shaped mounds on either side of their underground tunnel. These lateral tunnels coming to the surface are on the flat side of the fan and are plugged with soil. Using a long-handled spoon, carefully remove the plug. Insert one teaspoon of bait as far down as possible. Reclose opening, being careful not to cover bait with soil.

FOLLOW-UP: Wearing waterproof gloves, collect and dispose of dead, exposed animals. Dispose of leftover bait in accordance with disposal instructions. Use detergent and hot water to wash spoons used for application into burrows. Do not use spoon for mixing, holding or transferring food or feed. If reinfestation does occur, repeat treatment..
