GENERAL RECOMMENDATIONS

Aventine is a heavily chelated nutrient blend formulated for use with most liquid fertilizers and foliar sprays. Aventine contains a blend of key nutrients (K, S, Zn, Mn and B) which helps supplement a phosphorus starter fertilizer minimizing these key nutrients from being yield limiting factors. Aventine is intended for use and is compatible with most orthophosphate and polyphosphate fertilizers.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Use Aventine in conjunction with sound agronomic management practices including a balanced fertility program. Refer to the requirements of your state for specific crop recommendations.

APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

GENERAL GUIDELINES: Several variables are known to influence the proper rate of application to prevent or resolve a specific nutrient demand or deficiency. Limitations, Restrictions, and Exceptions

Corn, Potato and Sugarbeets: Apply as an in-furrow pop-up or in a 2 by 2 inch band at planting alone or in combination with other liquid fertilizers as prescribed by state recommendations.
