Kelpgrow is a foliar feed to aid plant growth and crop yields.

Kelpgrow is manufactured with a low temperature, non caustic process for minimal alteration of natural constituents.

Kelpgrow is supplementary to sound fertilizing practice.

Kelpgrow is obtained from fresh seaweed harvested in the pristine waters of British Columbia.

GENERAL USE AND RECOMMENDATIONS

Kelpgrow can be applied to all agricultural and horticultural crops, to fruit trees, turf and landscaping areas, flower beds and shrubs.

Dilute 1 unit of Kelpgrow in 250 units of water or as suggested at:

Spray mixture directly onto foliage until dripping.
