Although formulated specifically for citrus, this product may be used on all field, row, vegetable, fruit, tree, vine and ornamental crops for the prevention and correction of micronutrient deficiencies

Mixing and Handling Instructions

Fill mix tank with half of required water volume and begin agitation. Add products in this order, mixing thoroughly after each addition: adjuvants, pesticides, then fertilizers. Fill tank with remainder of water and continue agitation until solution is completely mixed. Check chemical mixture compatibility using a jar test prior to application.

ATTENTION: This product contains boron; use on any crops other than those recommended may result in serious injury to the crops. Limitations, Restrictions, and Exceptions

Field, Row, Vegetable, Fruit, Tree and Vine Crops:

Apply 1-2 quarts per acre per application throughout the growing season. At least 3 applications are recommended. More frequent applications at 1.5 quarts per acre may be needed to correct deficiencies once they occur.
