General Information

Fertigation

Application of Phytamin Fish is safe through most types of irrigation equipment including drip tape and aluminum pipe.

Phytamin Fish may not pass through some drip type irrigation systems. Always flush irrigation lines after Phytami treatment to prevent possible clogging or corrosion.

Always inject Phytamin in front of any filter system.

Phytamin Fish is mildly corrosive to aluminum in a concentrated form.

Not recommended for use in hydroponics. Please contact the manufacturer for information on special formulations.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Mix well before use.

Other Crops

Application Rates: Phytamin Fish may be used successfully on most crops. Please consult your dealer for rates and timing of applications.

Limitations, Restrictions, and Exceptions

Tomatoes

Phytamin Fish may be applied at any time throughout the bloom period.

Application Rate: $\frac{1}{2}$ - 1 gallon per acre at 10 to 14 day intervals throughout the bloom period.
