Fertigation

Application of Phytamin is safe through most types of irrigation equipment including drip tape and aluminum pipe.

Phytamin may not pass through some drip type irrigation systems. Always flush irrigation lines after Phytamin treatment to prevent possible clogging or corrosion.

Always inject Phytamin products in front of any filter system Phytamin is mildly corrosive to aluminum in a concentrated form.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Mix well before use.

Other Crops

Application Rates: Phytamin may be used successfully on most crops. Please consult your dealer for rates and timing of applications.

Limitations, Restrictions, and Exceptions

Cotton

To improve production, Phytamin should be applied as a foliar spray during the early bloom stages of growth.

Application Rates: $\frac{1}{2}$ - 2 gallons per acre in sufficient water to assure thorough coverage. Begin treatments at first bloom up to 3 weeks after first bloom. Treatments may be made up to three times at 10 day intervals.
