

## LETTUCE HEAD AND LEAF

Limitations, Restrictions, and Exceptions

Instructions

Application Instructions:

On direct seeded lettuce make the first application after emergence, thinning or prior to onset of disease development

On transplanted lettuce make the first application immediately after transplanting or prior to the onset of disease development.

Make a second application if conditions continue to favor disease development 14 days later.

Apply KENJA 400SC in sufficient water to obtain adequate coverage of the foliage. Spray volume will usually be 50 gallons per acre for dilute sprays and 5 to 10 gallons per acre for aerial sprays. For aerial applications, apply KENJA 400SC in a minimum of 5 gallons of water per acre.

Resistance Management:

Do not make more than 2 sequential applications of KENJA 400SC or other Group 7 containing fungicides before rotating to a fungicide with a different mode of action.
