

# **ALGAE TREATMENT - FOUNTAINS, WATER DISPLAYS, DECORATIVE AND SWIMMING POOLS/PONDS AND STANDING WATER (NOT FOR USE IN CA)**

## General Information

### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

### Limitations, Restrictions, and Exceptions

#### ALGAE TREATMENT

(Not for use in CA.)

FOUNTAINS, WATER DISPLAYS, DECORATIVE AND SWIMMING POOLS/PONDS AND STANDING WATER (Not for use in CA.): DO NOT use when fish are present. Remove floating type algae by raking, dragging with cable or chain, skimming, or any other suitable method. It is more economical to remove floating type algae before the water is treated. Treat water by “dribbling” this product using 1 part to 4 parts water (or equivalent use dilution) around the edges where visible algae growth is evident. Apply 12 ounces of use solution per 1000 gallons of water (or equivalent use dilution). The use solution is often dribbled liberally along the windward side to float across the water and along the leeward side where contamination gathers. Where a spray rig is available, it may be used to apply the use solution instead of the hand “dribbling” method.

NOTE: Algae does not usually grow in water that is 5 feet or more in depth. However, floating type algae may grow on pond weeds that grow on the surface of the water. Spray from fountains treated with this product will not harm poolside plantings. DO NOT use when fish are present.
