

Blueberry - Control Mummy Berry (Supplementary)

General Information

Application Instructions:

Initiate applications prior to disease development and continue on a 14-day interval. When disease pressure is high use the high rate.

Apply Kenja® 400SC in sufficient water to obtain adequate coverage of the foliage. Spray volume will usually be 50 to 100 gallons per acre for dilute sprays and 5 to 10 gallons per acre for aerial sprays. For aerial applications, apply Kenja® 400SC in a minimum of 5 gallons of water per acre.

Resistance Management:

Do not make more than 2 sequential applications of Kenja® 400SC or other Group 7 containing fungicides before rotating to a fungicide with a different mode of action. Do not apply the third application of Kenja® 400SC within 28 days of the second application.

Limitations, Restrictions, and Exceptions

Do Not apply more than 4 applications/A/year (62 fl oz/A/year (1.60 lb. a.i./A/year)) The Pre-Harvest Interval (PHI) for this crop is 7 days.
