GENERAL INFORMATION

PROMATE SCATTER is a blend of nonionic wetting agents impregnated onto an inert organic carrier. This results in a dry granular formulation that provides equal performance as liquid products when used at recommended rates. PROMATE SCATTER can be applied safely at full rates in both spring and summer.

PROMATE SCATTER is particularly useful for treating small areas of difficult to wet soil. PROMATE SCATTER also contains agents to prevent foaming problems.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

GREENS & TEES

In general, PROMATE SCATTER 21 lbs./1000 square feet every six month.

Early Season Applications: PROMATE SCATTER 6 lbs./1000 square feet. Apply when turf is dry. Rainfall or irrigation providing a minimum of 0.1 inch of water is necessary to activate the product. If necessary amounts of water have not been applied before next mowing, leave the baskets off.

NOTE: Rates given have been effective over a wide range of applications. Some applications may require lower, or higher rates for optimum performance.

Experimentation will reveal the optimum rate for your specific application.
