SMALL GRAINS - UNDERSEEDED WITH ALFALFA, BIRDSFOOT TREFOIL, LESPEDEZA, RED AND WHITE CLOVER

NOTE: When using on grains - do not forage or graze dairy and meat animals on treated areas within seven days of slaughter.

The nurse crop and weeds should provide a protecting canopy which, together with the use of low gallonage applied at low pressure, will reduce the risk of damage to the legumes. Do not apply to small grains underseeded with vetch or sweet clover, which are very susceptible. There is also some risk to other legumes if only thinly protected by a canopy.
