

GRASSES - ESTABLISHED GOLF COURSES, LAWNS - WEED CONTROL

Limitations, Restrictions, and Exceptions

GRASSES

Established Golf Courses, Lawns and similar Turf Grasses: Use 1 to 3 pints per acre in 10 to 100 gallons of water to give thorough coverage. Use higher rate for White top and Canada thistle. On smaller areas, use 1 fluid ounce (4 tablespoonfuls) mixed in 3 to 5 gallons of water and apply uniformly over 2,000 square feet. Do not mow within 2 days before or after application. Spring and fall are best times to treat. Do not use on lawns of creeping grasses, such as bent, except for spot spraying, nor on freshly-seeded turf until the grass has become well established.
