

## **POST-PLANTING APPLICATION**

### General Information

#### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Use this product on soils to control various plant nematodes such as: root knot, root-lesion, citrus, stubby-root, soybean cyst, sting, lance, stylet and dagger.

NEO-TEC G.S.O. may be applied using any hand or power operated gravity or rotary type spreader designed for application of granular types of materials. NEO-TEC G.S.O. may be used for pre-planting of annual plants or post-planting applications of annual, perennial or established plants, trees, or turf areas. NEO-TEC G.S.O. is also suitable for treatment of individual trees and shrubs.

#### REPEAT APPLICATIONS

NEO-TEC G.S.O. should be applied at least twice during the spring and autumn seasons. If conditions warrant, NEO-TEC G.S.O. may also be reapplied on an as needed basis.

Neo-Tec G.S.O. is activated by the presence of water, either by rainfall or by artificial application.

#### Limitations, Restrictions, and Exceptions

#### POST-PLANTING APPLICATION

Apply NEO-TEC G.S.O. as close to and around the plants as possible without damaging the plants at a rate of 200 lbs/acre of treated soil (4.5 lbs/1,000 square ft). Incorporate into the soil with suitable equipment as close as possible to the plants without injuring the roots.
