

LAWNS/TURF (WARM SEASON GRASSES) - MEDIUM RATE

General Information

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Apply only as directed during the growing season. Apply when a regular feeding of nitrogen, phosphate and potassium along with sulfur is desired.

This product should be used when a soil test has been conducted, within the last 36 months, and the test indicates that the soil is deficient in plant available phosphorous or the intended use is for establishing grass or repairing damaged grass during the growing season in which the grass is established.

For all applications:

- Apply to dry foliage.
- Water in after application with a minimum of 0.2 inches to help move particles into the turf canopy.
- Do not collect clippings for at least one mowing following application to avoid particle pick-up.

Do not apply near water, storm drains or drainage ditches. Do not apply if heavy rain is expected.

Apply this product only to your lawn and sweep any product that lands on the driveway, sidewalk or street, back onto your lawn.

Limitations, Restrictions, and Exceptions

LAWNS/TURF (WARM SEASON GRASSES) MEDIUM RATE

- Apply at the medium rate when temperatures exceed 90°F.
