

CITRUS, FIELD, ROW, VEGETABLE, FRUIT, TREE, VINE, ORNAMENTAL AND TURF CROPS - SOIL APPLICATION (MILD DEFICIENCY)

General Information

GENERAL INFORMATION

LIQUID ZINC 9% is especially recommended for citrus crops but may also be used on field, row, vegetable, fruit, tree, vine, ornamental and turf crops. LIQUID ZINC 9% alone, with pesticides, or with other fertilizers, may be applied directly to the soil or to the foliage of growing crops. LIQUID ZINC 9% may be applied via ground sprayer (high-volume or low-volume), aircraft or drip irrigation systems.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Soil applications of LIQUID ZINC 9% are recommended with nitrogen fertilizer solutions. Thorough coverage and wetting are needed for optimum foliar spray results. Actively growing plants with young leaves absorb foliar applied LIQUID ZINC 9% most efficiently. Immediate post-irrigation or post-rainfall application gives the best foliar uptake. Addition of urea (for example, 5 lbs. Lo-Bi Urea per 100 gallons of spray solution) will enhance foliar uptake of LIQUID ZINC 9%.

Limitations, Restrictions, and Exceptions

The lower rates are for field, row and vegetable crops and the higher rates are for fruit, tree, vine, ornamental and turf crops.

Fertigation : Apply the recommended amount of LIQUID ZINC 9% in split applications one to two weeks apart throughout the growing season.
